



PALLIATIVE CARE CENTRE

Palliative care services in India are woefully inadequate. The little that exists is focused on survivors of cancer. To provide these much-needed services to non-cancer patients, Sukoon Nilaya was crafted by the KGVM Trust in association with Cipla Foundation. This is a short-term stay facility for compassionate, holistic care, where patients can rest and receive services including symptom management and psycho-social support. The home care-giver is empowered with the skills to provide optimal care at home. There will be no charge for the services and facilities provided below.

FACILITIES AND SERVICES THAT WILL BE OFFERED

At Sukoon Nilaya, adult patients with advanced chronic renal, cardiac, respiratory and neurological diseases will be able to avail a range of services.

- OPD for patients requiring symptom and pain management

- Ward facility that can accommodate the patient along with a family caregiver
- Provision of care by a multidisciplinary team with specialists with expertise in
Palliative care, including counselling for patient and caregiver
- Physiotherapy and occupational therapy
- Support and training of the family caregiver in essential basic patient care
- Provision of a continuum of care with smooth transition to home-based care after
Discharge, and follow up of the patient as required
- Linkage to support services as may be needed, such as accessing assistive devices, legal aid, welfare services, etc

At Sukoon Nilaya, the care is *not* directed to extending the length of life. The focus is on symptom control, pain relief, psycho-social support, and training of the family caregiver. No extraordinary life-saving measures will be provided.

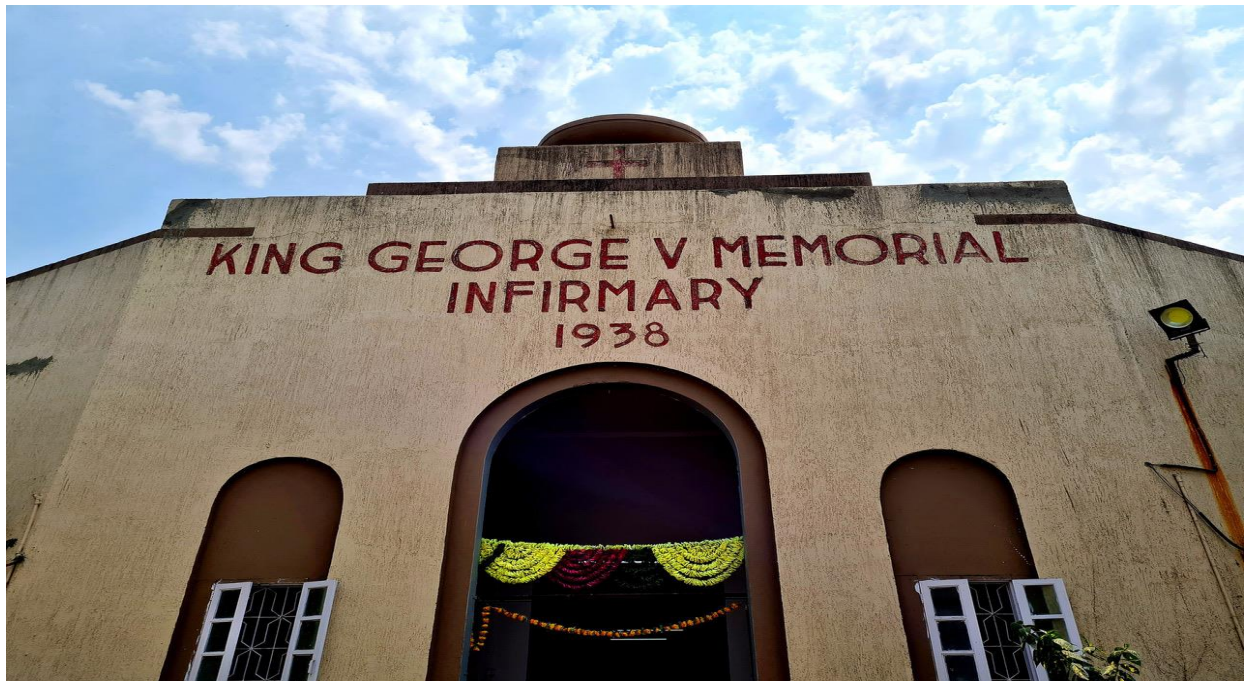

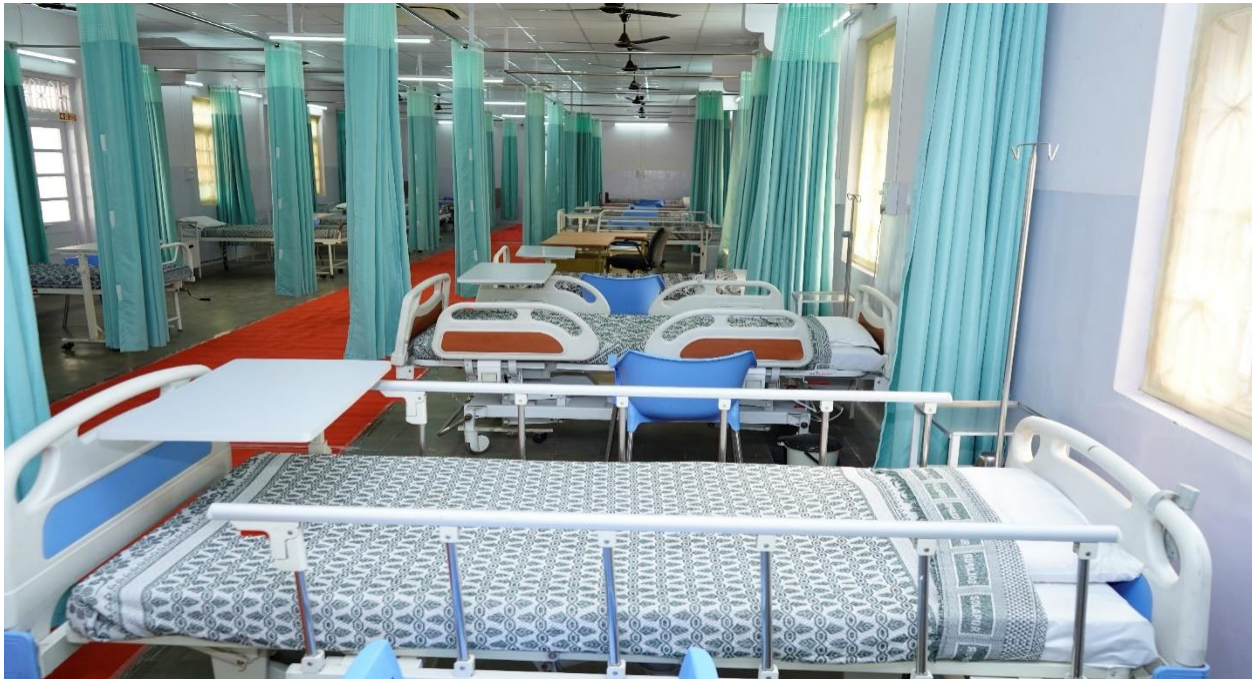

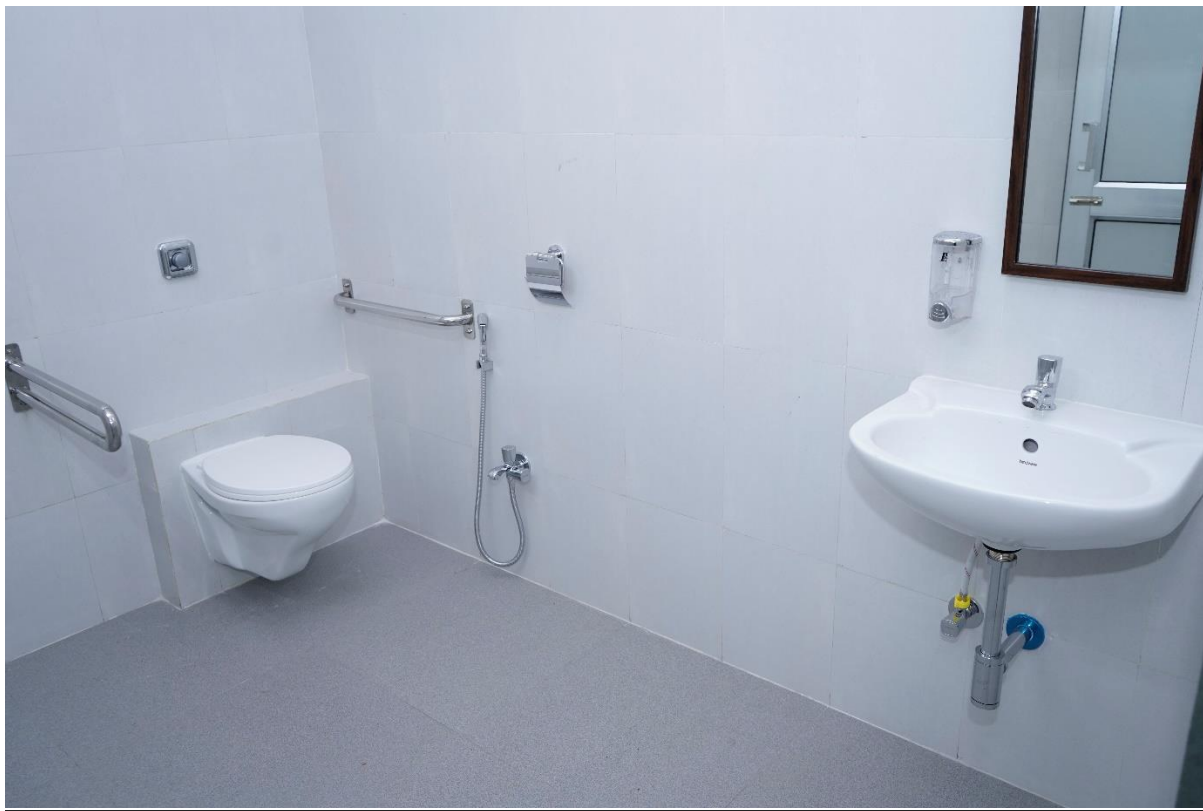
Indoor pictures of the ward:
