

Certificate Course in Essentials of Palliative Care July 2022

A Basic Course in Palliative Care for Doctors and Nurses

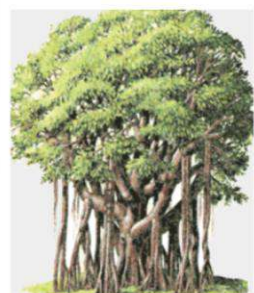
Course dates: 9th, 10th, 16th, 17th, 23rd and 24th July, 2022

(half day sessions, Saturday: 1 p.m. onwards; Sunday: 8 a.m. onwards)

Last date to submit applications: 30th June, 2022

The course aims to:

- inculcate the principles of palliative care in every day practice for doctors and nurses
- improve patient care through proper communication and effective management of difficult symptoms.



Course Outline

CCEPC has 2 components. Part A and an optional Part B.

Part A:

- Online half-day weekend theory classes on 9th, 10th, 16th, 17th, 23rd and 24th July, 2022
- Virtual submission of a Reflective Case History which will be evaluated by National Faculty.
- Online written examination in September, 2022.
- Candidates successfully completing the theory examination and the Reflective case history will be awarded the Part A Certificate in Essentials of Palliative Care.

Part B:

- An optional 10 day Hands on Training in Palliative Care.
- Training to be completed at a IAPC authorised course center for conducting Part B of the CCEPC.
- Candidates must submit a logbook duly attested by the mentor
- Successful completion of clinical attachment entitles candidates to receive the Part B certificate of the CCEPC

- Nursing issues
- Palliative Care in HIV/AIDS

- **Nurses** with **Diploma** in Nursing / **BSc** in Nursing
- **NOTE:** Select Clinical sessions will be held separately for Doctors and Nurses
